Sir/Madam,

With reference to your online application dated 28.6.2008 on the subject cited above, I am directed to convey the sanction for <u>Composite Provisional Affiliation for Secondary School Examination</u> of the Board for a period of three years w.e.f. 1.4.2012 to 31.3.2015.

The above sanction is subject to fulfillment of following conditions:

- 1. "School will follow the syllabus on the basis of curriculum prescribed by NCERT for the middle classes".
- 2. The school will implement Continuous and Comprehensive Evaluation (CCE) as per the schemes of the Board upto Classes X vide Circular No. 39/20-09-2009 dated 20.09.2009 in the school.
- 3. The school will follow the RTE Act, 2009 and instructions issued thereon by the CBSE/Respective State Govt/UT.
- 4. It is mandatory for every affiliated school to become a member in the local Sahodaya of CBSE schools.
- 5. The school will follow syllabi and courses as per scheme of studies prescribed by the Board for Secondary School Examination and changes made therein from time to time.
- 6. The school will enroll students proportionate to the facilities available in the school as prescribed in the Affiliation Bye-Laws of the Board which shall not in general exceed the optimum number as under:-

- (d) School running on bigger campus of more than 02 acres, the number of students shall be restricted as per the actual facilities in the school which shall be proportionate to the optimum number mentioned at (a), (b) and (c) above.
- 7. The School will not sponsor candidates for Board's examination of any other School/Branch, which is not affiliated.
- 8. The school shall sponsor regularly its bonafide and eligible students in Board's class X Examination from the year mentioned above without break or inform with reasons thereof in writing well in time about the non-sponsoring of the candidates. Failure to do so will lead to suo moto withdrawal of the affiliation of the school for secondary Examination granted by the Board.
- 6. The school should not start Class XI/XII without written approval of the Board. The Board shall not be responsible for any consequences in case class XI/XII is started without following the Affiliation Bye Laws and obtaining the prior approval of the Board.
- 7. The school shall appoint qualified and trained teaching staff on regular basis as per provisions of Affiliation Bye Laws of the Board.
- 8. Service conditions, pay and allowances and other benefits to the employees of the school shall be at least at par with that of corresponding categories of employees working in Government Schools of the State in which the school is located. An undertaking to this effect be sent to C.B.S.E.
- 9. Service agreement be executed with the staff as per norms generally accepted by the State Government concerned.
- 10. The school will help the Board in the smooth conduct of the examination by providing the necessary accommodations i.e. Rooms, Halls, etc. available in the school premises and furniture at its disposal for holding its examinations free of charges if required.
- 11. The school will spare sufficient teachers, for invigilation purpose at the examinations of the Board, as may be required.
- 12. The school will spare its teachers for evaluation of answer-books for the Board's examinations, if required.
- 13. The school will provide Laboratories, Library and other facilities as per norms of the Board.
- 14. The school will abide itself by the conditions of affiliation already prescribed by the State Government concerned.
- 15. The school should have at least one adequately equipped computer lab with a minimum of 10 computers or computer student ratio of 1:20 and proper software alongwith facility of Broad Band Connectivity with the feature of 'internet always on' from any service provider.

- 16. The school shall promote inclusion of student with disabilities/special needs in the normal school as per provisions of the 'persons with disabilities act -1995'.
- 17. The school and its records shall be opened for inspection by an officer/official of the Board or an authorized representative of the Board/State Educational Department at any time and the school shall furnish information as may be asked for by the Board/State Government from time to time.
- 18. The rate of tuition fee and other fees charged should be commensurate with the facilities provided.
- 19. The admission to the school shall be opened to all without any discrimination on the ground of religion, cast or race, place of birth or any of them.
- 20. No unrecognized classes shall run within the premises of the school or outside in the same name of school.
- 21. The school will strictly adhere with all rules regarding safety of students including Fire fighting, Drinking water, Sanitation, Transportation, etc.
- The accounts should be audited and certified by a Chartered Accountant and proper accounts statements should be prepared in the name of school, as per rules. A copy each of the Statements of Accounts should be sent to the Board every year.
- 23) The affiliation Code Number allotted to your school is 930948. This may please be noted and quoted for any correspondence with the Board.
- The school will create Reserve Fund as per the requirement of the Affiliation Bye Laws.
- (25) Annual fee of ₹ 4500/- @ ₹ 1500/- per annum for three years (01.04.2012 to 31.03.2015) be also remitted at an early date.
- The school will apply for further Extension of Provisional Affiliation 'on online' through www.cbseaff.nic.in with the prescribed fee of ₹ 25,000/- and other essential documents before 30th June of the preceding year before the expiry of the date of provisional affiliation.
- The school will open CBOE pattern classes IX w.c.f. 1.4.2012. Accordingly, 1st Batch of class X of the school will be appeared at the Board's Examination to be held in the year 2014.

- ii) The school is required to submit copy of the agreement executed with the Govt. of Kerala as mentioned in the NOC of the State Govt.
- iii) The school is required to obtain Fire safety certificate from concerned Deptt..
- iv) Number of books in the library is not as per Affiliation Bye-laws. As per norms it should have at least five books per student in its stock subject to a minimum of 1500 at the beginning excluding text books, magazines, etc.
- The School Managing Committee has not been constituted as per Affiliation Bye-laws, therefore, it may be reconstituted by including 02 representatives each of parents and teachers of the concerned school. Principal of the school should also be Member Secretary of the School Managing Committee.

Conditions for which compliance to be submitted within three months from the date of issue of sanction letter:-

- 1. Running starting of Class IX/X & XI/XII without prior Provisional Affiliation upto Secondary level/Sr. Secondary level from the Board would be unauthorized and school shall be responsible for the consequences arising out of it.

This is with reference to your online application dated 24.07.2014 on the subject cited above.

In this connection, I am directed to convey sanction for extension of provisional affiliation of the school with the Board for its Secondary School Examination for a further period of Five years w.c.f. 01.04.2015 to 31.03.2020 subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions in addition to the general conditions intimated at the time of grant of provisional affiliation for secondary classes:-

1. The School is required to follow syllabi and course as per scheme of studies prescribed by the Board for the respective Examination.

2. The School is required to abide itself by the Examination/Affiliation-Bye-Laws of the Board.

3. The School is required to apply on online for further extension of affiliation alongwith the requisite fee and other documents by 30th June of the preceding year in which the Provisional Affiliation expires. Applications will be accepted after the last date along with the prescribed fee and late fee Rs. 10,000/- per month subject to maximum of Rs. 50,000/-.

4. Provisional Affiliation granted to a school will remain valid on receipt of online application of a school for further extension of provisional affiliation subject to the final decision of the

Board.(Amended Rule 15.11)

5. It is mandatory for every affiliated school to become a member in the local Sahodaya of CBSE schools.

6. The school will enroll students proportionate to the facilities available in the school as prescribed in the Affiliation Bye-Laws of the Board which shall not in general exceed the optimum number as under from Pre-Primary to Class XII:-

e school will strictly adhere with all rules regarding safety of students including Fire fighting, rinking water, Sanitation, Transportation, etc.

Income & Expenditure and audited annual accounts statement duly certified by the Chartered Accountant for the current year is required to be sent and the same be submitted every year.

Other conditions are enclosed as per Annexure 'A'.

0. Special conditions to be complied within One month:-

a. Renewed Certificate from the concerned Govt. Authorities of the area relating to fire safety arrangement of the school be submitted at the earliest.

b. The school is required to reconstitute the School Managing Committee as per the provisions of Affiliation Bye-Laws of the Board by including two Board's nominees in it. In this regard a panel of five Principals (inclusive of at least 2-3 Principals from nearby JNV/KV) be forwarded.

c. The school is required to maintain the reserve fund as per norms of the Board under clause xxiii of

Affiliation Bye-laws of the Board.

d. The School should have qualified and trained teaching staff. Besides teachers be given prescribed pay scales alongwith DA and other admissible allowances at least at par with the State Govt. pay scales or 6th Pay Commission through ECS. The same can be checked and verified by the Board at any time.

e. The Salary should be paid through Electronic Clearing Service (ECS) from the date of First appointment of the teachers on probation. Salary should be transferred in the individual accounts

of staff through ECS.

f. The school is required to súbmit compliance of conditions conveyed vide this office letter dated 11.09.2012 duly supported with documentary evidences.

g. The School should have adequate infrastructure including building playground etc. as per Affiliation Bye-Laws.

Provisions of Affiliation bye laws for adherence:-

- 1. Fees should normally be charged under the heads prescribed by the Department of Education of the State/U.T. for schools of different categories. No capitation fee or voluntary donations for gaining admission in the school or for any other purpose should be charged / collected in the name of the school and the school should not subject the child or his or her parents or guardians to any screening procedure i.a.w. rule no. 11.1, 2 & 3.
- 2. The school should not use the activities for commercialization:
 - a) As per rule no. 19.1 (ii) It shall ensure that the school is run as a community service and not as a business and that commercialization does not take place in the school in any shape whatsoever.
 - b) As per rule no. 19.1 (ii)a Any franchisee school making payment on account of use of name, motto and logo of franchiser institution or any other non-academic activities would be termed as commercialization of institution and to provide an affidavit that the school/society has not entered into any such contract to use Name, logo, motto for consideration of fee.
- 3. Teachers are to be made educated regarding corporal punishment & should avoid any type of such involvement i.a.w. rule no. 44.1 (d & e).
- 4. School will not prepare any student/ start class for any other Board except CBSE from their CBSE affiliated school building/premises.
- 5. Admission to the school is to be made restricted under rule 6.1 of Examination bye laws and rule 12 (i, ii & iii) of Affiliation bye laws.
- 6. The school has to constitute a committee for protection of woman from sexual harassment at the work place and to abide by the guidelines and norms prescribed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in W.P. Criminal No.666-70 of 1992 Vishaskha and other State of Rajasthan and other delivered on 13.8.1997 mentioned under rule no. 10.9.
- 7. Each school affiliated/ to be affiliated with the Board shall frame Service Rules for its employees which will be as per Education Act of the state/U.T., if the Act makes adoption of the same obligatory, otherwise as per Service Rules given in Affiliation Bye Laws. Further, Service contract will be entered with each employee as per the provisions in the Education Act of the state/ U.T., or as given in Appendix III, if not obligatory as per the
- 8. Pay and allowances to staff should be revised time to time to bring it at par with that to State Government. Further, Salary and service conditions of staff should be provided i.a.w. rule no. 3.3 (v) and rule no. 10.2 as appended below:
 - a. The school in India must pay salaries and admissible allowances to the staff not less than the corresponding categories of employees in the State Government schools or as per scales etc. prescribed by the Government of India." Further, the service conditions as per Rule 10 and Rules 24 to 49 of Affiliation Bye-Laws also be adhered to.
 - b. Salary should be paid through Electronic Clearing Service (ECS) from the date of first

- 9. Continuous sponsoring of students at board examination is to be made as per rule 13.12 (iv).
- 10. As per rule 13.12 (ii), no affiliated school shall endeavour to present the candidates who are not on its roll nor shall it present the candidates of its unaffiliated Branch/School to any of the Board's Examinations.
- 11. Running of classes of **coaching institutions** in the school premises in the pretext of providing coaching to the students for various examinations is not approved by the board. Strict action would be taken on defaulters.
- 12. As per rule no. 8.2 and 13.11, facilities for physically challenged student should be adequately provided and every school shall promote inclusion of student with disabilities/special needs in the normal school as per provisions of the 'Persons with Disabilities Act 1995'.
- 13. Health, sanitation and fire safety should be adequately equipped i.a.w. rule no. 3.3 (vii), rule 8.5 and rule 23.11.
- 14. School infrastructure and teachers for examinations conducted by the board and evaluation of answer scripts should be made available as per rule no. 13.4.
- 15. As per rule no. 8.8 (iv & v), every affiliated school to develop their own website containing comprehensive information such as affiliation status, details of infrastructure, details of teachers, number of students, address-postal and e-mail, telephone nos. etc.
- 16. As per rule no. 3.3 h (vi), every school should organize at least one week training programme for teachers every year in association with any teachers training institute recognized by the State or Central Government or by any agency identified by the Board.
- 17. Every secondary and senior secondary school shall appoint a person on full time basis for performing the duties of a **Health Wellness teacher** as per rule 53.5.
- 18. Strict adherence to the provisions of **Wild Life Protection Act** while procuring plants and animals for the use in laboratories by the school must be made i.a.w. circular no 03 dated 21 May 2013.
- 19. As per rule 15.1 (d), the school will follow the syllabus on the basis of curriculum prescribed by NCERT/CBSE and text books publishing by NCERT/CBSE for the Middle classes as far as practicable or exercise extreme care while selecting books of private publishers. The content must be scrutiny to preclude any objectionable content that hurts the feelings of any class, community, gender, religious group in society. If found prescribed books having such content, the school will have to take responsibility of such content. Provided that the school would put a list of such books prescribed by it on its website with the written declaration duly signed by the Manager and the principal to the effect that they have gone through the contents of the books prescribed by the school and own the responsibility.
- 20. The school should keep a copy of Affiliation/ Examination Bye Laws for reference purpose and also advised to visit CBSE websites www.cbseaff.nic.in & www.cbse.nic.in for updates.



- 2. The School is required to apply on online for further extension of affiliation along with the requisite fee and other documents as per Rule 10.3 of Affiliation Bye Laws, 2018.
- The school will also abide by the conditions prescribed, if any, by the State Government concerned as mentioned in certificate as per appendix III issued by District Education Officer (DEO) /equivalent officer
- The school should ensure the strong governance and management of its activities in way of comprehensive and quantifiable planning in way of curriculum planning, infrastructure, resources, physical education, staff development and other co-curricular areas.
- The school should go through the provision of **Affiliation and Examination Bye Laws and keep a copy there of** for reference purpose and also advised to visit CBSE websites i.e. http://cbseacademic.nic.in/ & http://cbse.nic.in/ for updates. The School is expected to see all circulars on these CBSE websites regularly.
- The school will strictly adhere to all rules regarding safety of students including Fire fighting and Transportation, etc. Further, school will provide adequate facilities for notable drinking water and clean healthy and hydrenic toilets with washing facilities for hows and
- 6. will provide adequate facilities for potable drinking water and clean healthy and hygienic toilets with washing facilities for boys and girls separately in proportion to the number of students. - 13. The optimum Section teacher ratio of 1:1.5 as well as student teacher ratio of 30:1 is to be maintained to teach various subjects and school shall appoint qualified and trained teaching staff on regular basis as per provisions of Affiliation Bye Laws of the Board.
- Every affiliated school shall sponsor regularly its bonafide and eligible students in Boards Class X and Class XII examinations from the year mentioned while granting affiliation/up-gradation regularly without break or inform with reasons thereof in writing well in time about the non-sponsoring of the candidates.
- 15. Running of coaching institutions in the school premises in the pretext of providing coaching to the students for various examinations is not permitted by the Board. Strict action would be taken on defaulters.
- 16. The Manger and the Principal of the school shall be jointly responsible for the authenticity of the online/offline documents/information/data submitted by the School to the Board.
